

# **Training and Development Policy**

### **Policy Statement**

Tic Tag Systems is committed to providing a place of work and systems of work, which minimises risks. Tic Tag Systems ensures that personnel performing work affecting service quality are competent on the basis of appropriate attitude, aptitude, education, training, skills and experience. Risks arising from inadequate or poor training will be addressed in accordance with Tic Tag Systems Training Management Plan.

## **Policy Objectives**

To achieve our goal we:

- Determines the necessary competence for personnel performing work that affects service quality.
- Created and maintain a training matrix setting out each person's qualifications and training. This matrix incorporates a skills gap analysis and as personnel are available, Tic Tag Systems schedules any required training stemming from this gap analysis utilising the intended training matrix.
- Provide required training and demonstrate that all our personnel meet the requirements of our clients and projects
- Maintain appropriate records of education, training, skills and experience.

#### **Employee & Contractor Commitment**

Tic Tag Systems are committed to providing the necessary training for all employees to perform their job at the highest standard. Employees are encouraged to approach management with specific training that may be required or add value to themselves and our clients. Training is not solely the responsibility of Directors and Senior Management. All personnel are encouraged to take ownership of their Training needs and their fellow workers as befits an interdependent team.
